Apart from direct interventions around energy, water and waste management, the program engages students and staff with a curriculum that provides knowledge and tools on conservation and sustainability. The program also offers fruitful volunteering opportunities, for corporate volunteers, peers and alumnae, parents and local communities.

High level job responsibilities

- Align with the objective of the school program to Work with the TIDE team to implement the program in selected schools
- Liaison with schools, conduct need assessment and identify for partnering
- Contribute to creating school specific intervention package
- Implement the package in selected school campuses starting with baseline survey, interventions on energy, water and waste management (eg. solar roof top, water harvesting, waste segregation, water treatment and reuse, efficient electrical appliances, etc) and Curriculum delivery
- Facilitate volunteer engagement initiatives at the school
- Undertake activities to bring in ownership by school community including teachers, parents, and local community
- Track impact with data and document the same

Eligibility criteria

- Science / engineering degree with a strong technology aptitude ; post-graduation desirable
- Minimum 5 years work experience out of which 3 years should have been around handling sustainability projects / education projects

Essential Attributes:

- Ethical and honest
- Passion for environmental sustainability & education
- Familiar with data-based planning, implementation, and impact assessment
- Excellent communication and networking skills ; knowledge of Kannada desirable
- Good digital skills with understanding of using tools for content creation, conducting sessions, etc
- Willing to travel extensively within Bangalore and to program sites out of station on need basis

Preferred attributes

- Familiarity with purchase / procurement processes and vendor management
- Volunteer handling experience / CSR project experience
