Our Model School Programme helps children become agents of change addressing issues concerning the environment and other civic issues that impact them and the community around them. This involves interaction with children and teachers in middle and high schools. Eco-friendly interventions in energy, water and waste management are key components of the program. The program has impacted children, teaching and non-teaching staff in Karnataka and Tamil Nadu through 13 partner schools last year and around 50 schools in total since inception.

We are looking for a self-motivated, result-oriented team leader thereby achieving the objectives of the program.
