For Empanelment of Vendors for Civil Works - Medicinal Garden Development in Primary Health Centres (PHCs)

Location: Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh

1. Background

Technology Informatics Design Endeavour (TIDE), a not-for-profit organization working on sustainable development, is implementing the "Medicinal Garden Development" Project. The objective is to establish traditional medicinal plant gardens at Primary Health Centres (PHCs) to promote indigenous healthcare practices and provide access to medicinal plants for rural communities.

2. Scope of Work

TIDE invites Expression of Interest (EoI) from eligible vendors/agencies for the following civil works in 20 PHCs in Prakasam District, Andhra Pradesh:

a) Site Preparation and Ground Development:

- Land preparation, leveling, and soil conditioning for medicinal plant cultivation
- Construction of boundary walls/fencing for garden protection
- Development of pathways and access routes within the medicinal garden

b) Infrastructure Development:

- Construction of water storage tanks and irrigation systems
- Installation of drip irrigation or sprinkler systems
- Construction of tool storage sheds and maintenance facilities
- Development of composting areas and organic waste management systems

c) Garden Layout and Planting Infrastructure:

- Construction of raised beds and planting areas (300-550 sq meters per PHC)
- Installation of plant identification boards and signage
- Construction of seating areas and educational spaces
- Development of medicinal plant processing and drying areas

3. Timeline for Completion

All civil works across the 20 PHCs must be completed within 45 days from the date of award of contract.

Hence, agencies must have multiple implementation teams capable of working in parallel across different PHC locations.

4. Eligibility Criteria

The applicant agency must:

- Be a registered legal entity in India (Company, Partnership, LLP, Proprietorship, NGO).
- Have a minimum of 2 years of experience in civil construction and landscaping projects.
- Have executed at least 2 similar projects in the past 2 years (preferably in public sector, healthcare settings, or agricultural/horticultural infrastructure).
- Possess required technical certifications and licenses for construction work as per local regulations.
- Be compliant with applicable laws and taxation norms (GST, PAN, etc.).
- Have adequate manpower and resources to deploy at least 3-5 teams simultaneously across multiple locations.
- Experience in medicinal plant cultivation infrastructure or agricultural civil works will be preferred.
